ORIGINAL: Desafiar →

To challenge / defy
"Ella decidió desafiar las expectativas."

"She decided to challenge expectations."

💡 Cognate with "defy" (des- + -fiar).

ORIGINAL: El ferrocarril →

The railway / train track
"El ferrocarril cruza todo el país."

"The railway crosses the entire country."

💡 Roll the double 'r' clearly!

Card 01/08

ORIGINAL: De repente →

Suddenly
"De repente, empezó a llover fuertemente."

"Suddenly, it started to rain heavily."

💡 Synonym of "súbitamente".

Card 04/08

ORIGINAL: Agradecido →

Grateful / thankful
"Estoy muy agradecido por tu ayuda."

"I am very grateful for your help."

💡 From the verb "agradecer" (to thank).

Card 03/08

ORIGINAL: Desarrollar →

To develop
"Queremos desarrollar nuevas tecnologías."

"We want to develop new technologies."

💡 Noun form: "el desarrollo" (development).

Card 06/08

ORIGINAL: El atardecer →

The sunset
"Vimos el atardecer desde la playa."

"We saw the sunset from the beach."

💡 Related to "la tarde" (afternoon/evening).

Card 05/08

ORIGINAL: Pernoctar →

To spend the night / stay overnight
"Tuvimos que pernoctar en un albergue."

"We had to stay overnight in a hostel."

💡 From Latin "pernoctare" (through the night).

Card 08/08

ORIGINAL: A menos que →

Unless
"No iré a menos que tú vengas conmigo."

"I won't go unless you come with me."

💡 Always triggers the subjunctive mood!
